### Summary

Los Gatos Youth Theatre (LGYT) provides youth programming for the performing arts. LGYT is seeking qualified Teaching Artists to work with 6-14 year olds during our summer camp programming (late May to July, 2022) and 7-18 year olds for our summer production series from (late April to July in 2022.) Teaching artists will be responsible for creating real-world theater based lesson plans that will culminate in an end of camp product. Teaching artists at camp will collaborate with the Camp Director. Production instructors will collaborate with the Artistic Director.

We are seeking Teaching Artists in the following disciplines:

- Choreography
- Stage Makeup
- Set Design/Painter
- Vocal Direction

### Primary Responsibilities

- Create daily lesson plans for camp classes.
- Teach lessons with support of a youth counselor.
- Manage and monitor every student in the class.
- Coordinate with the Camp Director.
- Stage/Set Design: Oversee building of set, working alongside counselors and students.
- Stage/Set Design: Make changes to set as necessary.
- Provide estimations on how much the class supplies will cost.

- Enjoy working with children.
- Innovation, Creative vision.
- Communication and collaboration skills.
- Experience practicing and facilitating an arts experience.

### Time and Compensation

Productions rehearse from May to July, auditions are in the last week of April.

Camps run from June 6 to July 22.

Approximately 15 hours per week.
